

PUNCH BIOPSY CHECKLIST

SUPPLIES FOR PROCEDURE:

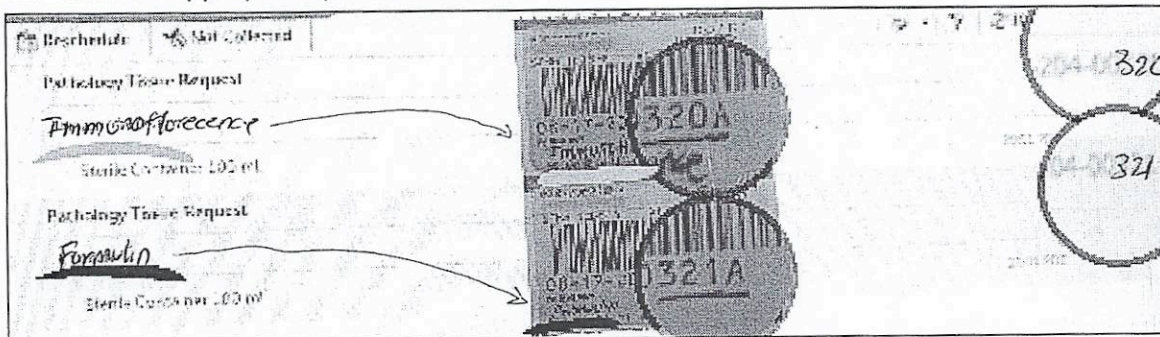
- 1) Signed consent
- 2) Formalin - grey - (med room top shelf)
- 3) Immunofluorescence - green - (med room refrigerator/lab)
- 4) Gloves (ask MD which size they require*)
- 5) Chloraprep with handle
- 6) Patient drape (in burn unit OR)
- 7) 1% Lidocaine (20ml) with epi
- 8) 5ml syringe
- 9) x2 Punch biopsy
- 10) Laceration tray (central or main med room). If out of stock, include:
 - a) 18G needle and 30G needle
 - b) Forcep and clamp (x1 suture removal kit and x1 all purpose kit) (Dr. Grossman has his own)
- 11) 4.0 Prolene suture
- 12) 4x4 gauze

ORDERS:

- 1) Under orders/plans add order for: **Pathology Tissue Request**
 - a) Pre-op example: "TENS"
 - b) Post-op example: "Rule Out TENS"
 - c) Specimen description example: "R leg"
 - d) Procedure: "punch biopsy"
 - e) Clinical Hx example: "Rash"
 - f) Under Order Comments: "**Immunofluorescence**"
- 2) Under orders/plans add order for: **Pathology Tissue Request**
 - a) Pre-op example: "TENS"
 - b) Post-op example: "Rule Out TENS"
 - c) Specimen description example: "R leg"
 - d) Procedure: "punch biopsy"
 - e) Clinical Hx example: "Rash"
 - f) Under Order Comments: "**Formalin**"

SPECIMEN COLLECTION LABELING:

- 1) Print out a specimen label for both the Immunofluorescence and Formalin orders
- 2) Match labels appropriately. See below for details.



- 3) Write "immunofluorescence" on the correct label and post it to the immunofluorescence vial. Write "formalin" on the correct label and post it to the formalin vial. Time, date, and sign the vials
- 4) Hand deliver both vials to the lab
